June weather turns terrible

After two of the hottest months on record, June was the driest for 34 years with less than three quarters of an inch of rain.

At the Halesowen Climatological station rainfall was well down, temperatures about ^{average} ~~normal~~ and sunshine a little up on normal.

The maximum of 25°C (77°F) was one of the lowest for a decade, with a minimum of 6.1°C (43°F) on the 16th.

There was no frost, and with rain falling on only 9 days June ~~was~~ ~~the~~ at least was dry, if not hot, with only 18 hours rain fall.
