

GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE MONTH.

THE HOT SUMMER WEATHER CONTINUED FOR THE FIRST THREE DAYS OF SEPTEMBER, THE MAXIMUM OF 24C(75F) BEING NOTED ON THE 2ND. AFTER THIS DAYS, AND PARTICULARLY NIGHTS, BECAME COOLER. THE AVERAGE TEMPERATURES WERE THUS LITTLE DIFFERENT FROM THE 30 YEAR MEANS. GROUND FROST WAS NOTED ON TWO NIGHTS LATER IN THE MONTH, MORE THAN IS CUSTOMARY.

THE MONTH WAS AGAIN UNUSUALLY DRY, THE 28MM(1.11IN) PROVIDING ONLY 39% OF NORMAL. RAIN FELL ON 12 DAYS OF THE MONTH FOR A TOTAL OF 35 HOURS MUCH OF THIS IN THE LATTER PART OF THE MONTH.

SUNSHINE WAS AGAIN ABOVE NORMAL BY SOME 20%, WITH 2 DAYS SUNLESS, THE 24TH BEING THE FIRST SUNLESS DAY SINCE JUNE 18TH.
