

GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE MONTH.

TEMPERATURES HAVE HELD UP WELL, MOST BEING NEAR OR A LITTLE ABOVE THE 30-YR MEANS. HOWEVER, NIGHTS HAVE BEEN BOTH COLD AND FOGGY. TWELVE GROUND FROSTS AND 5 FOGS OCCURRED, BOTH WELL ABOVE NORMAL.

RAINFALL IS STILL DEPRESSED, ONLY 66% OF THE AVERAGE FALLING, AND SUNSHINE HAS FINALLY DIPPED BELOW THE 30-YEAR MEAN, ONLY TWO THIRDS OF THE CUSTOMARY AMOUNT BEING RECORDED. THE 12 SUNLESS DAYS MADE THE MONTH RATHER DEPRESSING THOUGH NO SNOW FELL JUST A LITTLE SLEET ON THE 24TH.
