

Spring 1993 ranked 6th in overall conditions since 1956.
making it another very open season.

With a mean daily temp of 9.1C (48F) it was slightly below
the 9.8C of 1992 but still 1.1C above the 30yr mean. All soil
temps were well above expectation though grass minima were
near average. Both air & ground frosts were down on usual.

Rainfall was ~~about~~ only marginally below normal at
177mm (6.97ins). With the number of rain days (36) being
considerably better than average.

Sunshine at 415 hrs was near the 30yr mean of 414 hrs
though the 16 sunless days was worse than expected.

No day of gale was reported though gusts to gale force
occurred in both April & May reaching 41 knots.
